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#### SUMMARY OF REGULATIONS

- ✓ No child can be employed under the age of 13
- ✓ A young person must hold a work permit (Employment Card) for each employment.
- √The employer must make application for a work permit within one week of employing a
  young person.
- Each year all young people must have a 2 week period free from employment during their school holidays.

#### HOURS OF EMPLOYMENT

No child shall be employed during school hours, or before 7am or after 7pm on any day

#### TERM TIME

Maximum 12 hours in a week

Maximum of 2 hours on any school day

(1 hour before and 1 hour after school or 2 hours after school)

Saturday maximum of 5 hours (4 hours and then 1 hour break)

Sunday maximum 2 hours

## **HOLIDAYS**

Maximum of 25 hours per week

Maximum 5 hours per day (4 hours and then 1 hour break)

Sunday maximum 2 hours

# 13 YEAR OLDS MAY NOT BE EMPLOYED IN ANY WORK OTHER THAN TO UNDERTAKE LIGHT WORK IN THE FOLLOWING:

- café
- agriculture
- shop work
- newspaper delivery

- hotel
- horticulture
- office work
- car wash

- restaurant
- riding stables
- hairdressing

#### **TERM TIME**

Maximum 12 hours in a week

Maximum of 2 hours on any school day

(1 hour before and 1 hour after school or 2 hours after school)

Saturday maximum of 8 hours (4 hours and then 1 hour break)

Sunday maximum 2 hours

#### **HOLIDAYS**

Maximum of 35 hours per week

Maximum 8 hours per day (4 hours and then 1 hour break)

Sunday maximum 2 hours

\* Every young person requires a work permit whilst they are of compulsory school age. They are of compulsory school age until the last Friday in June of year 11.
