

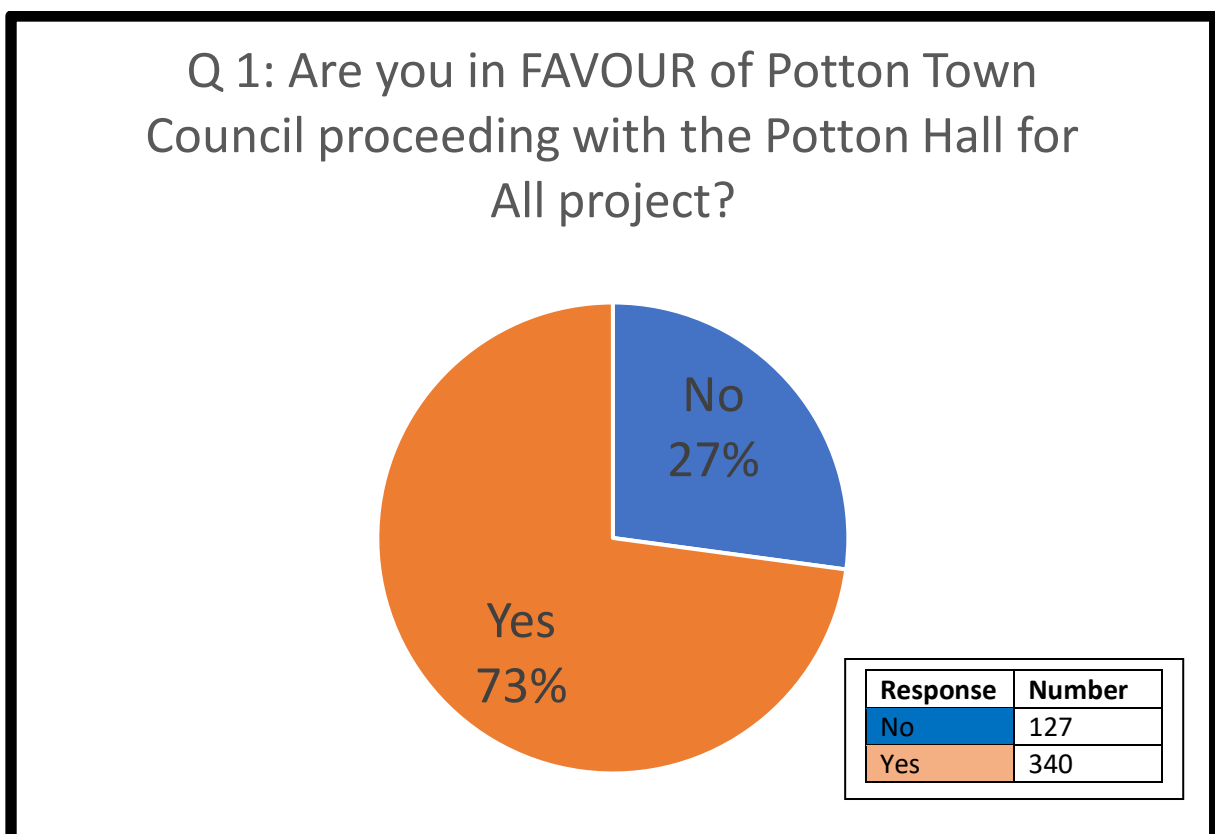
# Survey Result

Number cast in favour of <b>Yes</b>	340	73%

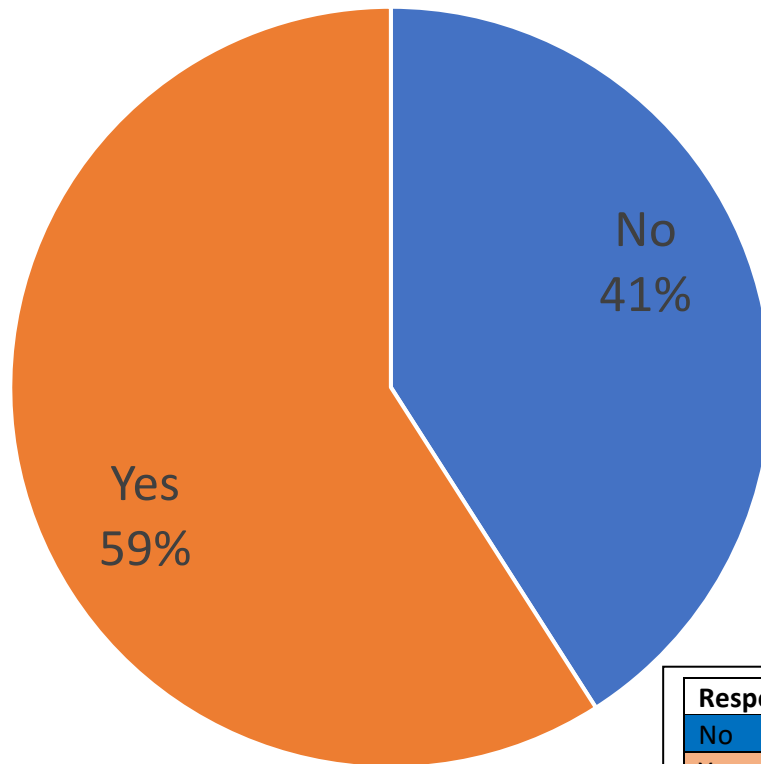
