



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)

(POTTON: BYWAY OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC NO 7)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

Notice is hereby given that Central Bedfordshire Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot or on horseback or lead a horse or cycle or motorcycle or drive a motor vehicle along the full length of Byway Open to All Traffic No 7, Potton which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 2079 4950 to OS GR TL 2105 5051

This temporary closure is required to enable surfacing works. The closure is expected to take place from 1st August to 18th August 2022.

There is no safe alternative route for pedestrians, cyclists and equestrians while the closure is in operation.

The alternative route for motorcycle or motor vehicle users while the closure is in operation is via Potton Road, Everton Road, Mill Lane, Newtown, Sandy Road and Deepdale.

The Order will come into operation on 1 August 2022 for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to the Byway have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
