(POTTON FOOTPATH NO 4)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2019

Notice is hereby given that the Order made by Central Bedfordshire Council on the 4 March 2019 the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along Footpath No 4, Potton which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 2204 4862 to OS GR 2164 4870 has been continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 11 March 2022.

This temporary closure is required to allow for construction access. The closure is expected to continue from 12 September 2020 to 11 March 2022.

The alternative routes for Footpath users while the closure is in operation will be Potton Bridleway No 8.

The Order will continue in force until 11 March 2022 or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within eighteen months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
