1. Apologies for absence

2. Declaration of Interest

Councillors were reminded that they should declare an interest in any matter of personal or prejudicial interest to be discussed at this meeting.

3. Public Participation Session

Cllr Macdonald requested to speak regarding the recent spate of accidents outside no. 3 Wrestlingworth Road (three accidents within eight days with the most recent occurring on 9th August) and the need for the Town Council to support the residents of Wrestlingworth Road to try to bring about a successful resolution to the traffic calming measures.

It was suggested that this matter should be added to the September Town Council meeting agenda and to invite the residents from Wrestlingworth Road to attend.

A discussion about the how this issue can be publicised due to the inaction from Central Bedfordshire Council and four local MPs. None of the local news channels seem to be interested.

A member suggested getting in touch with the Road Victims Trust who support victims of accidents, to see if they could do anything to put some weight behind traffic safety in the area.

Cllr Macdonald asked if the Town Clerk might have a copy of the Police road survey that was done on Wrestlingworth Road.

The Chairman volunteered to contact Cllr Zerny and ask him to bring his thoughts to the September meeting.

It was **resolved** to **i.** add Wrestlingworth Road to the September Town Council meeting agenda and **ii.** invite the residents from Wrestlingworth Road to attend.
