

#### 3. Aim and objectives

Aim of the plan: To increase the short-term community resilience.

- i) Identify vulnerable elements of the community;
- ii) Identify hazards and possible mitigation measures;
- iii) Identify resources and key contacts in the community.

#### 4. Emergency Co-ordinator

A person living locally who provides a vital link between the community and other organisations planning and responding to an emergency.

Their role is to:

- Oversee the completion and maintenance of the Community Emergency Plan;
- Provide a link to Central Bedfordshire Emergency Planning Officer;
- Call a community meeting during an emergency (if deemed necessary);
- Provide the focal point for the community response to an emergency.


